B1 What is the Decision?	To approve the signing of the Deed of Novation of Contract with Go Plant Fleet Services Limited for the provision of Vehicle Hire and Maintenance.
B2 What are the reasons for the Decision?	The Council has an existing contract with Gullivers Truck Hire Ltd for the provision and maintenance of its vehicle fleet. This fleet is deployed to undertake the Council's statutory duties for both waste collection and street cleaning.
	Following a robust procurement exercise for which the Council received full assurance from its auditors, the contract commenced in November 2015, for a five year term, with the option to extend for a further one year. On 18 December 2018, the Council received a
	letter from KPMG LLP stating that Gullivers had been placed in administration.
	In the following days, the Council was made aware that an alternative fleet provider, Go Plant Fleet Services Limited (GPL), had agreed terms with the administrators to procure all the vehicles used by the Council under the terms of its agreement with Gullivers.
	Furthermore, GPL stated that they would like all rights and obligations under the contract to be transferred to them. This may be achieved by way of a Deed of Novation of Contract.
	Therefore, the signing of the Deed will ensure that the Council can continue to use the vehicle fleet under the same contract hire and maintenance terms as previous.
	During their discussions with the Council, GPL has also indicated that they would like to secure the one year extension to the contract and receive an uplift on the contract hire rates. Both these items currently remain under negotiation and do not form part of this decision notice.
