1. Purpose of the Report

1.1 For the Council to note and approve changes to the Council's Constitution.

2. Background

- 2.1 The Council is required to adopt its Constitution annually.
- 2.2 This report brings forward the latest proposals for changes.

3. <u>Contribution to Corporate Priorities</u>

3.1 This report does not directly contribute to Corporate Priorities but the Council's Constitution is an important document in enabling the Council to implement the Corporate Plan.

4. **Proposed Changes to the Constitution**

4.1 Part 4G (Disciplinary Procedures for Statutory Officers) – amend the Procedures to ensure consistency with Schedule 3 of the Local Authorities (Standing Orders) (England) Regulations 2001 as amended by the Local Authorities (Standing Orders) (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2015; and with the Model Procedure set out in the JNC

Conditions of Service for Chief Executives (October 2016 edition); and with the JNC Conditions of Service for Chief Officers.

- 4.2 Part 3J (Senior Officer Employment Committee_ amend paragraphs 2.1, 2.3, 2.10, 2.13 and 2.14 to provide consistency with Part 4G.
- 4.3 Part 5A (Code of Conduct for Councillors) amend the Code as recommended by Standards Committee at its meeting on 7th April 2021, by adopting the LGA Model Code of Conduct for Councillors with the following modifications:
 - At 7.2 of the LGA Model Code, delete all words following "political purposes"
 - Retain 3.4 of the existing Part 5A (on the subject of the IHRA Working Definition of Anti-Semitism)
 - Retain 3.5 of the existing Part 5A (on the subject of the APPG Definition of Islamophobia)
 - Retain the wording of paragraph 11 of the existing Part 5A (on the subject of Dispensations)

5. Re-adoption of Constitution

The Council is recommended to re-adopt the whole Constitution on an annual basis. The proposed changes outlined above are available at the appendices to this Report. In all other respects the Constitution remains unchanged from that adopted on 21st December 2020.
