#### 1. <u>Purpose of the Report</u>

1.1. The Council is requested to appoint the members of the Independent Remuneration Panel and to agree its terms of reference.

#### 2. <u>Background</u>

- 2.1. The Council is required to undertake a review of its Members' Allowances scheme by its Independent Remuneration Panel under the 4 year rule. The Local Authorities (Members' Allowances) (England) Regulations 2003 (SI 1021) (the '2003 Regulations') require all local authorities to establish and maintain a Panel that must be convened to provide advice on Members' allowances before a Council changes or amends its allowances scheme. Council is being asked to authorise the commencement of the review.
- 2.2. An Independent Remuneration Panel produced its first report on a Review of Members Allowances in November 2002. This was followed by further reviews in respect of Pensions, Travel and Subsistence and Co-optees Allowances (July 2003) and Pensions and Licensing Panel Members' Allowances (February 2004), a fourth report (May 2007), a fifth report (March 2011) and supplementary report on a review of special responsibility allowances for the Chairmen of the Audit Committee and of the Relevant and Better Value Scrutiny Committee. The sixth report was produced in March 2015.

- 4.1. Dr Declan Hall (consultant) chaired the panel in 2014/15 with three other lay members (Mr Andrew Gentles, Mr John Jackson OBE, JP and Mr Paul Laffey).
- 4.2. It is proposed that Dr Hall fulfils the role he has previously undertaken as Chairman, to lead in the review of the Member's Allowances, in accordance with the Independent Remuneration Panel Terms of Reference.
- 4.3. In order to comply with the statutory regulations the Council is formally requested to appoint the three laypersons to the Panel. These are as follows: Mr Paul Laffey, Mr Simon Chapman and Mr Shaid Hussain.
- 4.4. Council is also requested to formally approve the terms of reference for the Panel which are also set out in the recommendations.
