#### 1. Purpose of the Report

1.1 For the Council to note and approve changes to the Council's Constitution.

#### 2. Background

- 2.1 The Council is required to review its Constitution regularly.
- 2.2 This report brings forward the latest proposals for changes.

#### 3. <u>Contribution to Corporate Priorities</u>

3.1 This report does not directly contribute to Corporate Priorities but the Council's Constitution is an important document in enabling the Council to implement the Corporate Plan.

#### 4. **Proposed Changes to the Constitution**

- 4.1 It is proposed that Part 3Zc (Proper Officers) should be amended to reflect current staffing arrangements. The proposed amendments are all shown as tracked changes on the document at Appendix 1.
- 4.2 In October 2109 the Secretary of State for Housing, Communities and Local Government wrote to all Council Leaders in England on the subject of the adoption of the International

Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) Working Definition of Anti-Semitism. A copy of the Secretary of State's letter is at Appendix 2 while the IHRA Working Definition is at Appendix 3. It is proposed that Part 5A (the Code of Conduct for Councillors) and Part 5B (the Code of Conduct Officers) should both be amended to give effect to the Secretary of State's letter. Since the original version of this report was circulated a request has been received from Cllr Chaudhry that those parts of the Constitution be further amended to include reference to the All-Party Parliamentary Group (APPG) on British Muslims' Definition of Islamophobia. All proposed amendments are shown as tracked changes: in the case of Part 5A there is a proposed new paragraph 3.4 and in the case of Part 5B there is proposed additional wording at the existing paragraph 3.2 (see the documents at Appendix 4 and Appendix 5 respectively).

#### 5. Financial Considerations
