<a href="#">742/17</a>	To approve the monies needed for ecological surveys to move forward with the land at Lynwood Road, Branston 2nd or 3 EDRs	A report went to Cabinet in February 2016 which recommended that land for self build must be made available if the self build sector was to grow, and so it would be huge benefit for the Council to provide a real development opportunity in the sector. The Council owned site at Lynwood Road has been chosen for the proposed pilot scheme. The site appears to be marketable for a self-build pilot project due to its size, location and existing infrastructure that can be linked into. Stage 1 of the first phase of the project is now complete. The marketing event was held on 31st January to establish interested parties who are committed to delivering self build in the Lynwood Road location. For this event a register of all interested registrations of attendees and non-attendees will be compiled along with which plots people have expressed an interest in and any details of what they would like to build. To move to stage 2 of the project approval of monies for the completion of ecological surveys from Growth Point funding is needed.	No	No	14/03/2017
