The review of such areas is covered under Section 71.  The Council has a statutory duty to consult on the conservation area appraisals in accordance with Section 69 the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990, including boundary amendments for a period of six weeks. There were two boundary amendment consultations which took place in October and November 2016 and August and September 2018. The Council received 3 representations at each consultation.
