Re: Temporary Event Notice – Branston Arms

On 14 August 2017 Staffordshire Police received a temporary event notice from Gavin Watts, Branston Arms, 115-116 Branston Road, Burton on Trent. The notice requested an extension to their trading hours from 01.00 hours to 07.00 hours on Sunday 27 August to allow them to sell alcohol for the screening of a boxing match.

The premises is situated off the town centre and in an area with a significant amount of residential premises and historically we have had a number of complaints of noise and anti-social behaviour associated to the premises. The premises licence does not have conditions suitable to a late opening venue that could provide some mitigation to police concerns and the Designated Premises Supervisor has only been at the premises in that capacity for a month and only had a personal licence for 3 months and we do not believe that he has shown us a level of experience to reassure us that he is capable of ensuring that the licensing objectives are not undermined.

Staffordshire Police object to the granting of the temporary event notice as we believe that should the event be allowed to go ahead then the licensing objectives of the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety and public nuisance would be undermined.
