Hi,

Temporary event notice was received on the 14th of August 2017 for the live screening of a boxing match and sale by retail of alcohol within Branston Arms, 115-116 Branston Road, Burton upon Trent, DE14 3DD. Mr Gavin John Watts who is the Designated Premises Supervisor has requested for trading hours to be extended from 1am to 7am on the 27th of August 2017. Objection for the request has been made because of the past history of noise complaint from residents and also because of the location of the pub which is in a residential area. Environmental Health Department have received one noise complaint every year for the past 3 years. On one occasion in July 2016, the reporter had to ring the police around 12.20am because she believed the noise emanating from the pub was too loud. Although all the complaints received were closed because the diary sheet sent to the reporters were not returned back to Environmental Health Department as part of the investigation process.

Further reason for the objection is because Staffordshire Police have made a recommendation for refusal due to past history of noise and anti-social behaviour complaint associated to the Branston arms.

East Staffordshire Borough Council cannot guarantee that Branston Arms will be free from noise nuisance, so therefore cannot approve this Temporary Event Notice because the licensing objectives of the prevention of crime and disorder, public safety and public nuisance would be undermined.
