Prevention of Crime & Disorder

An incident register or electronic equivalent of all occurrences and ejections from the premises must be maintained at the premises and any details of any incidents of crime or disorder offences must be recorded. The register must be produced and made available at the time of the visit for inspection upon request by any responsible authority.

Prior to selling alcohol, all persons involved in the sale of alcohol & age restricted products who are not the holder of a Personal Licence must receive initial and regular 12 monthly refresher training by the Designated Premises Supervisor or external training provider with regards to the law in relation to the sale of alcohol & age restricted products. Such training must be recorded and up to date training records of all such persons must be maintained at the premises and produced and made available at the time of the visit to any Responsible Authority. There must be twelve months records retained.

Both initial and subsequent refresher training in relation to the sale of alcohol & age restricted products must contain a test to be undertaken by the staff member and this test or online certificate must be made available at the time of the visit to any Responsible Authority. There must be twelve months records retained.

Public Nuisance

A notice advising customers to leave the premises quietly and respect the needs of residents must be displayed at each of the exits of the premises.

Public safety

There must be no opened vessels containing any alcoholic/non-alcoholic drinks taken from the boundaries of the premises.

Protection of Children from Harm

A Challenge 25 policy must be adopted and enforced at the premises where all persons who appear to be under the age of 25 must be challenged for acceptable identification to prove they are over the age

of 18 prior to the purchase of alcohol. The only acceptable forms of identification are a valid photo driving licence, valid passport or a valid PASS approved proof of age card.

Challenge 25 posters must be displayed at all entrances to the premises, all areas where alcohol is displayed and at the cash till payment area.

Posters must be displayed prominently and in sight of customers & staff.

A refusals register or electronic equivalent with details of all refusals must be maintained at the premises. The register may be contained on the till but must contain details of the staff member refusing the sale.

The refusals register or when on the till a print out of refusals must be produced and made available for inspection at the time of the visit by any Responsible Authority.
