RE: REVIEW OF PREMISES LICENCE – NEW INN, TUTBURY

Further to the blue poster that has been put up outside The New Inn, Tutbury applying for a review of the premises license on the grounds of the Prevention of Crime & Disorder and The Prevention of Public Nuisance, I write to confirm that I would like to support the request as I feel that the licensing hours need to be reduced.

I live opposite the premises in a development for the over 55's and for the past 3-4 years I have experienced situations that have occurred which make me feel vulnerable and frightened in my own home. I do not like these situations and I become very worried.

My apartment overlooks Ludgate Street and one of my reasons for buying this apartment is so that I could sit in my window and watch the world go by from the comfort of my own home. However, I have experienced verbal abuse from the customers of the New Inn when they are hanging around on the footpath outside the pub. They shout abuse at me and tell me that they were here before me. I can't enjoy the activities of the village and feel that I must move away from my window to avoid any further abuse. Sometimes I have tried to speak back to them through my window but I am always abused with aggressive and foul language which is very distressing.

The situation is not just contained to the daytime. There is also a lot of noise from the customers when they leave late at night, which I find more worrying and difficult to deal with. This happens mainly during the weekends late on a Friday & Saturday night.

The customers are usually shouting and swearing and hanging around the doorway of the pub and outside people's homes opposite me. I am unable to sleep and need to take co-codamol to make me drowsy so that I can get some sleep in the early hours of the morning. I am finding that I am becoming addicted to the co-codamol as it is turning into a normal activity to take the tablets.

I have also had to have secondary glazing fitted in my bedroom which has cost me £400. This was to try and help keep out the noise. The noise is also created by bands and music playing at the New Inn which also contributes to the disturbance which I am finding more and more difficult to cope with.

There are also 3 other residents on my floor who face the New Inn. There is a 94-year-old resident, a lady with cancer and another lady who has an illness which keeps her in bed most of the time. These people are either too elderly or too ill to make a representation for themselves so I am also writing to you on their behalf.

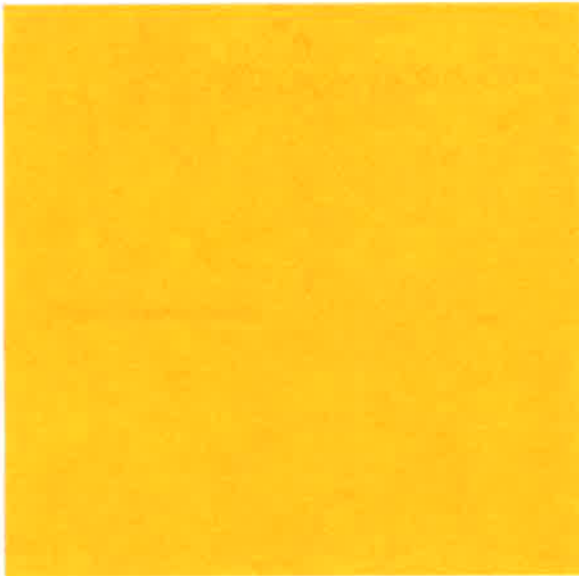
As I no longer drive and cannot go out when the noise and behaviour becomes too much I feel like I am a prisoner in my own home with no means of escape.

Along with these issues I have also seen people coming out of the pub and urinating up my neighbour's properties, leaning all over parked cars, leaving glasses in the street and on people's window sills and generally having no respect for the residents of our village.

I ask the committee to take my comments in this letter seriously when it comes to reviewing the license.

To prevent public Nuisance.

I have witnessed loud shouting in the street late at night. This is normally on a Friday and Saturday night, in the early hours of the morning.

The customers stand on the footpath drinking and smoking and blocking the footpath.

Recently the noise and nuisance seems to start on a Thursday and go through until Sundays.

Only this weekend there were 2 people shouting and creating nuisance and I had to get out of bed as this woke me up.

In the past the language is foul and unnecessary.

To prevent crime and disorder

I have witnessed people urinating against property on Ludgate Street and acting disorderly when leaving The pub.

I have been shouted at and had verbal abuse shouted at me for looking out of my window, again the use of foul language directed at me.
