<b>To prevent crime and disorder</b>	YES	Objecting against Flavas to open later than 11pm will prevent the risks of more crimes and disorder. Relating this to the employees of Flavas Grill. They are well known for abusing the substance of illegal drugs. This is a crime and brings many other people to the shop to hang about rather than using it for its actual purpose. Delivery driver is driving without an insurance. This has been reported before and the delivery driver still seems to be driving.
<b>Public safety</b>	YES	The delivery driver is constantly making U-turns from wherever they are parked despite the areas surroundings of pubs (drunk adults) and traffic situation. This is done from right outside our house rather than takin a safer route or stopping to turn on the next up-coming street. This increases the chances of car accidents and collisions as many have occurred outside our house before due to drugs and un-safe drivers. Even a death has sadly taken place recently due to drunken adults and car accidents
<b>To prevent public nuisance</b>	YES	Relating this to more people being on the streets at late nights and a pub a few doors down, this increases the chances of arguments being started and a public nuisance increasing. Loud noises, loud cars and music causes a public nuisance and the disturbance of the people living just cross the road.

<b>To protect children from harm</b>	YES	Objecting against Flavas new opening hours will protect the children from harm and discomfort due to being able to get them in to a settled sleeping schedule and routine. There are 4 children in the house we live in. Relating this to the way the delivery driver has chosen to take off his journey by making risky decisions of making U-turns from anywhere, this risks the children's safety as well as adults and if this was to be prevented it would protected their wellbeing.
