I would like to state that we are not against the pub being open during normal opening hours, we are just concerned about the affect the present application for longer opening hours and music events will have upon us and other residents of the village on Kingstone.

Public Safety

As stated on the form, vehicles are already parking on the pavement opposite the pub on a regular basis as the pub has limited parking. On some occasions vehicles have been parked on the road also, for quite a way down the road. As the road is narrow it causes access problems for larger vehicles which could be a problem should an ambulance etc. need to get through. I have enclosed a couple of photographs of recent parking, however, it has been much worse.

To prevent public nuisance

The premises is in the middle of the village of Kingstone, surrounded by houses, and the parking problem (as stated above) will only be worse should the pub be open for longer hours and for music events. This will cause a nuisance for much of the village. Vehicles leaving the premises have to travel through the village. After 11.00pm this would be a nuisance for many residents.


It will especially cause a nuisance to me and my husband as our house is less than 2 mtrs away from the pub

We live next door the pub and we are **very** close. I have enclosed a photograph of an aerial photograph taken a few years ago and you can clearly see how close we are. The extended hours will affect our quality of life, in particular keeping us awake. We sleep in the bedroom closest to the pub - this is the largest bedroom in the house and neither of the other two would be suitable as they would be too small for my husband because he is disabled. There are about seven or eight car parking spaces at the front of the pub and as customers leave in their cars we can hear them talking and closing their car doors guite loudly even when our windows are shut. This would be totally unacceptable after 11pm and up to 1am, and beyond. Customers also use the area just outside the front of the pub as the smoking area where tables and ash trays are provided. Please look at the photo of the pub at the top of their facebook page https://www.facebook.com/shrewkingstone/ Obviously if they come out in groups to smoke we can also hear the chatter and laughter very clearly. This would be much worse in the summer when people stay outside for longer and we have to have our windows open - they are only yards away. The music would not be a problem up to 11pm (although parking would be), but after that it would be a nuisance as it would affect our sleep and quality of life.

I have outlined the problems that we face, but I am sure that many other neighbouring properties will be affected by this also. I am not sure how many people know about the extension application as not many have The Echo where the notice was posted. I did not see it until I was told about it by a friend.
