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Hi,

I cannot see an application reference on the notice but with regard to the property at the above address please see my concerns below.

With regard to the above property and change to licensable activities I would like to raise concerns to the use of Live and recorded music outside and to potential seating on the pavement.

We have 9 letting bedrooms that look out on to the high street. The windows are old and single glazed due to the building being listed. I have concerns that outside music or singing may disturb paying hotel guests whilst trying to sleep or relax at night.

Also, with tables on the pavements, people talking loudly at night may disturb residents as above with the singing and cause complaints. refunds and loss of repeat business.
