<a href="#">741/17</a>	To officially 'make' or adopt the Uttoxeter Neighbourhood Plan, after the successful Referendum on 2nd February 2017.	<p>The Uttoxeter Neighbourhood Plan was subject to Referendum on Thursday 2nd February 2017. In the referendum the question asked was:</p> <p><b>Do you want East Staffordshire Borough Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Uttoxeter to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?</b></p> <p>The result of the Referendum in the Parish was as follows:</p> <p><b>1770 votes (17.84% turnout)</b>  <b>1508 Yes</b>  <b>246 No</b>  <b>16 rejected</b></p> <p>The Referendum result was a 'yes' vote of more than 50% therefore in accordance with section 38A(4) of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (and Regulation 19 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012) the local planning authority must publish a decision statement setting out the decision (please see separate 'decision statement') and the reasons for making that decision. The LPA must also send a copy of the decision statement to the qualifying body and any person who asked to be notified of the decision.</p> <p>Regulation 20 of the neighbourhood planning regulations states that the LPA must publish the neighbourhood plan on their website and details of where a copy can be inspected.</p> <p>A minor amendment will also be made to "map 2" which is on pages 9 and 77 of the Plan to correct an error regarding the classification of sites given planning permission in Uttoxeter versus sites that have been allocated through the ESBC Local Plan.
