95/20 REGULATION 10A REVIEW OF THE LOCAL PLAN

At this juncture Councillor A A Chaudhry left the meeting.

The report of the Head of Service (Sal Khan) on the regulation 10a review of the Local Plan was considered.

The following appendices had been circulated with the report:

• Appendix A: Performance of adopted Plan in terms of delivery against all objectives;

• Appendix B: Compliance of Local Plan policies against the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF) and the National Planning Policy Guidance.

Council noted the Development Plan Committee had met on three occasions to discuss the approach to reviewing the Local Plan and had endorsed the recommendation as set out in the report. It was noted that in assessing the need to update the Local Plan the following were considered:

- National legislative updates/ National policy;
- Strategic direction of the Authority;
- Land Supply position (5 year land supply);
- Performance of adopted Plan in terms of delivery against objectives;
- Significant environmental changes;
- Delivery of infrastructure;
- Wider strategic impacts e.g. neighbouring authorities' unmet housing needs;
- Proposed changes to plan making as set out in the current Planning White Paper consultation.

The driver for undertaking an update to the Council's Plan was linked to the lack of alignment with the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF). The NPPF had significantly changed since the existing Plan had been adopted and the Council's policies would need to be updated to reflect these changes. The Council had maintained a strong 5 year land supply position and performed well at appeal. This indicated that the policies in the existing Plan were still relevant and robust. Housing delivery performance had been effective and there was still a good supply of sites to be delivered. A thorough review of all policies in the plan had been undertaken in terms of delivery and compliance with national policy, which had not indicated that there would be an urgent or essential need to update the policies in the immediate short term.

Resolved:

That the update to the Local Plan be delayed for a maximum of 5 years, with an annual review carried out (as recommended at the meeting of the Development Committee held on 23rd September 2020).
