Benchmarking Report (Quarter Two Performance 2018/19)

1. Introduction

- 1.1. The following report details figures for Quarter Two of the 2018/19 financial year i.e. 1st April to 30th September 2018 for a number of local authorities initially identified using the CIPFA 'Nearest Neighbours' model. The following authorities provided figures for this benchmarking exercise:

Where no additional comment has been made to highlight variations, then the report assumes that the figures provided are cumulative and that they are calculated in accordance with recognised NI / BVPI definitions.
