## Benchmarking Report (Quarter Two Performance 2017/18)

## 1. Introduction

- 1.1. The following report details figures for the financial year 1<sup>st</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2017 for a number of local authorities initially identified using the CIPFA 'Nearest Neighbours' model. The following authorities provided figures for this benchmarking exercise:

- 1.4. Some variations have been highlighted so please take these into account when considering this report.
- 1.5. Where no additional comment has been made to highlight variations, then the report assumes that the figures provided are cumulative and that they are calculated in accordance with recognised NI / BVPI definitions. Other comments provided by the relevant participating authority have also been detailed where appropriate.
