THIS NOTICE is issued by the Council, in exercise of their power in section 183 of the 1990 Act, because they consider that it is expedient that the activity specified in this notice should cease before the expiry period allowed for compliance with the requirements of the enforcement notice on the land described in paragraph 3 below. The Council now prohibits the carrying out of the activity specified in this notice. Important additional information is given in the Annex to this notice.

3. THE LAND TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES

Land at Green Lane, Marchington, Staffordshire shown edged red on the attached plan.

4. ACTIVITY TO WHICH THIS NOTICE RELATES

The notice prohibits the stationing of any additional caravans, mobile homes and vehicles on the land.

5. WHAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO DO

Do not bring any additional caravans, mobile homes and vehicles on to the land

6. WHEN THIS NOTICE TAKES EFFECT

This notice takes effect on 17th September 2011when all the activity specified in this notice shall cease.



If you wish to contest the validity of the notice, you may only do so by an application to the High Court for judicial review.
